
- 1. **Emails to expect:** After you complete your registration, you will receive several emails from <a href="mails-e
 - Virginia Cooperative Extension User Name this email confirms the username you have set on your new registration account
 - b. **Virginia Cooperative Extension New Account Set Your Password** this email provides a link to set your password for your new registration account. This email comes right after you have completed your registration, and the link is only valid for 30 minutes.

All Registrants (new and existing accounts) will also receive the following emails from vceprograms@vt.edu:

- a. **Virginia Cooperative Extension Enrollment Notification** this email confirms your enrollment in the program
- b. **Virginia Cooperative Extension Confirmation** this email provides special information about your course enrollment, including detailed instructions for accessing the program on the Canvas system. This email also includes an attached PDF of your payment receipt.
- c. **Receipt Notification** this email is from bursar@mail.bursar.vt.edu, and provides details of your credit card payment.

2. Canvas Guest Account Activation Process: Within 2 hours of registering, you should receive a Virginia Tech Guest Account Invitation email from Virginia Tech Guest Management Service (iam@vt.edu). It is important that you watch for this email as it has a temporary link for you to activate your VT guest account and set your password. You must active your account within 7 days of receiving the email or the invitation will expire. If you do not see this email come in within 2 hours of registering, please be sure to check your spam, junk and trash folders in your email. The email looks like this:




3. Click on the link in the VT Guest Account Invitation email and follow the on-screen instructions to activate your guest account. The activation screen looks like this:




4. Be sure you receive a verification from the system that your Guest Account has been successfully activated:






6. To sign into the Canvas course site, please go to https://profdev-lms.tlos.vt.edu/.



7. Log in to Canvas using your Guest ID, which is the email address you used to register. The password is the one you set when activating the VT Guest Account. To reset your VT Guest account password, visit the Guest Account Management Service - Password Reset page at https://webapps.es.vt.edu/gams/reset.do. Enter the email address you used to register for the course.
